

3 Green patents (development of environment-related technologies)

Definition and scope

This indicator measures the share of environment-related technology patents against the total of technology patents developed by a country.

Factsheet rationale

This is a key indicator to track societal responses to green economy needs by tracking the number of patents of importance to green growth.

Current situation and progress in the Mediterranean region

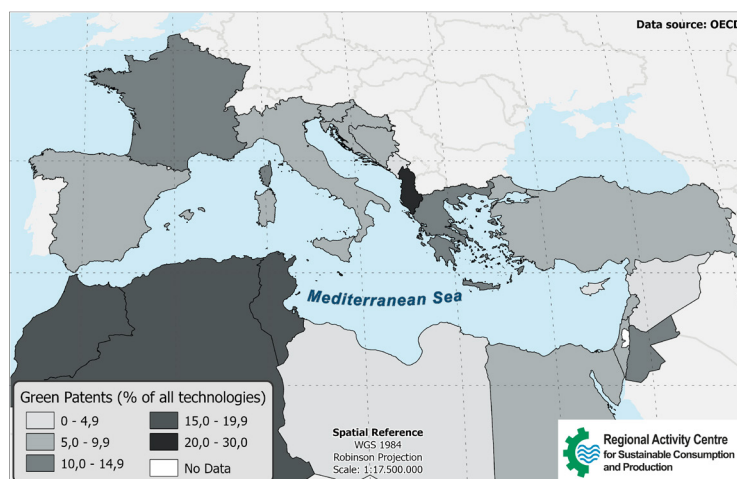
A few countries have developed a significant share of environment-related technology patents, ranging from 15% to a maximum of 30% of the total number of technology patents. However, the remaining countries show a share below 15% in environment-related technology patents.



Key message

The proportion of patents to promote green growth remains below 15% in most Mediterranean region countries.
